DIRECTIONS



- A sheet of heavy paper, such as cardstock
- Forks
- Paint in a variety of colors
- Green marker or crayon
- A paper plate
- 1. Pour your paint onto your paper plate.
- 2. Dip your fork into the paint. Make sure the entire back of the fork is coated in paint!
- Stamp the fork onto your paper to create a flower! Continue stamping your paper with different color flowers until you are happy with your creation. Use a green marker or crayon to create stems, leaves, and the ground.
